President's Message:

Fellow Compatriots, DAR Daughters & Friends...

As we welcome the *New Year*, it is with pride and humility that I thank you for the high honor of serving as your President for the past year. Supported by a most amazing team of committed Chapter Officers, we have continued to exceed chapter goals and expectations, and despite trying times of national discord, the loss of beloved *Compatriots Alex Dreyfoos, Jim Blackburn* and *Bill Told* the *Palm Beach Chapter SAR* prevailed, grew and produced some admirable accomplishments.

As reported by *FMR President & Historian, Don Lanman*, over the past 10 years, Chapter accomplishments include; growing chapter membership to 185 compatriots, averaging an annual membership renewal rate of 85%, promoting over 80 JROTC, BSA awards and Youth Essay programs, recognizing over 75 Law Enforcement/First Responders with medals, awarding 11 scholarships to local University History majors and supporting over 80 Veterans related events and programs.

During the past 10 years the Chapter has, by any reasonable definition, set a standard for other SAR Chapters from conducting well managed interesting meetings to a Chapter that includes 2 *National Officers*, 1 SAR President General, 1 SAR National/International Inspector General, 1 SAR Minuteman Medal, 2 SAR Gold Citizenship Medals and 10 Patriot Medal winners.

Now, as I transfer the gavel of authority to the incoming *President* for the *Palm Beach Chapter National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution,* I enjoin upon him the duty of wielding it with dignity, impartiality and courtesy, never forgetting that, although as Officers we are temporarily the chiefs among our *Brethren*, we have only emerged for a brief time from the ranks and to those ranks we all soon return.

As I return to the ranks, I encourage all *Chapter Compatriots* to remember that the *Palm Beach Chapter* is blessed with a large number of qualified and exceptional leaders, and I have every confidence that *President Johnston* and the *2024* team of Officers will lead our Chapter to new levels of success. I intend to continue my Chapter service as our Treasures Peter Johnston's assistant treasurer during 2024.

The 2024 Chapter Officers will be formally installed, by SAR National Inspector General & Former Chapter & State President Ray Wess, during the January 16th meeting.

During the November meeting, the Chapter celebrated *Veterans Month* where we honored all *Veterans* from the original *American Veterans* of *1776* to the present day.



We honored the 23% of our membership who are *Veterans*, and heard from *Chapter Veterans* as they shared interesting stories of their *Military Service* from *Korea* to the deserts of the *Middle East*, as part of our annual "*Soldiers Voice*" program.

Veteran's Voice speakers included; Compatriots Richard Linn USN, Robert Boggs USMC, Benjamin Tidwell III USA and Donald Lanman USA.



The Chapter remembered the passing of beloved *Compatriot William H. Told Jr.*, age 93, with a heartfelt *Memorial Service* during the November meeting. Compatriot Told was a retired *Businessman*, *Philanthropist*, *Korea War Era USAF Veteran* and a loyal devoted 33-Year member of the *Palm Beach Chapter SAR*.



Chapter Compatriots also honored and celebrated the life of our beloved *Compatriot* and *USAF Korea War Era Veteran Alexander W. Dreyfoos*, during a special ceremony at the *Kravis Center for the Performing Arts*, "*Dreyfoos Hall*" in West Palm Beach.

The *Palm Beach Chapter* joined *DAR Daughters* to honor our Veterans by supporting the *Wreaths Across America Veterans Wreath* placement program in December. *Compatriots Johnston* and *Garrison* placed an *Honor Wreath* at the grave of Veteran and SAR *Compatriot Jim Blackburn*.

As an *FVF Ambassador*, the Chapter is supporting *Florida Veterans Foundation Gadsden Flag "Don't Tread on Me" Specialty Florida License Plate*, fundraising program. \$25 from each license plate sold benefits Florida Veterans in need. License plates are available online at local Florida vehicle offices.

"The American Creed" 106 Years of Patriotism!

April 3rd 2024 is the 106th Anniversary of the Revered American Creed!

The American Creed represents a concise statement of the defining elements of American identity. It was first formulated by *Thomas Jefferson* and elaborated on by other American Patriots. The creed's message includes *liberty, equality, individualism, populism,* and *laissez faire*.

The American Creed resulted from a nationwide contest in 1917 for writing a "National Creed", which would embody and represent a summary of the American political faith founded upon ideas fundamental in American history and tradition.

The contest was the idea of *Henry Sterling Chapin*, Commissioner of Education of New York State, and from over 3,000 entries, *William Tyler Page* was selected as the winner. Page's winning entry went on to become the official "*American's Creed*" as the result of a resolution passed by the U.S. House of Representatives on April 3, 1918.

~THE STORY BEHIND PAGE & THE AMERICAN CREED~

William Tyler Page (1868–1942), was a descendant of John Page, who came to America in 1650 settling in Williamsburg, Virginia. Another Page ancestor, Carter Braxton, signed the Declaration of Independence, and ancestor, John Tyler, served as the Governor of Virginia, a US Senator and the 10th President of the United States.

William Tyler Page came to Washington at the age of thirteen to serve as a Capitol page. Later he became an employee of the Capitol building and served in that capacity for almost sixty-one years.

In 1919, he was elected clerk of the House. Thirteen years later, when the Democrats again became a majority party, they created for Page the office of minority clerk of the House of Representatives where he served for the remainder of his life.

In the words of William Tyler Page, "The American Creed is a summing up, in one hundred words, of the basic principles of American political faith.

It is not an expression of individual opinion upon the obligations and duties of American citizenship or with respect to its rights and privileges.

It is a summary of the fundamental principles of American political faith as set forth in its greatest documents, its worthiest traditions and by its greatest leaders."

"I believe in the United States of America, as a government of the people, by the people, for the people; whose just powers are derived from the consent of the governed; a democracy in a republic; a sovereign Nation of many sovereign States; a perfect union, one and inseparable; established upon those principles of freedom, equality, justice, and humanity for which American patriots sacrificed their lives and fortunes.

I therefore believe it is my duty to my country to love it, to support its Constitution, to obey its laws, to respect its flag, and to defend it against all enemies."

The American Creed has held a special place in the hearts of National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution Compatriots and Daughters of the American Revolution Patriots not simply for its stirring words, but because William Tyler Page was both a descendant of our patriot ancestors and fellow Compatriot of the Maryland Society Sons of the American Revolution.
