## TRIBUTE TO BENJAMIIN FRANKLIN...



This statue of Benjamin Franklin is located in Boston in front of the Old City Hall, on the spot where the original Boston Latin School once stood.

The school was founded on April 23, 1635, and is the oldest public school in America.

Ben Franklin attended the Boston Latin School for only about two years, starting when he was 8 years old. While Franklin had little formal education, His curious nature and love of knowledge educated him.

The bronze plaques surrounding the base illustrates the many different roles in Franklin's storied life.

One panel is Franklin as a printer, another shows him during his famous lighting experiment, while another illustrates Franklin's skill as a diplomat and his role in drafting the Declaration of Independence.



Benjamin Franklin accomplished so much during his lifetime that a much larger statue base would be required to show them all!

This statue was erected in 1856 to honor Franklin's 150th birthday. It was the first portrait statue to be erected in Boston, which means the subject is depicted as he actually appeared, rather than draped in toga, cloak, or classical attire.





Graduating from MIT and Harvard Business School, Alex founded Photo Electronics Corporation (PCS), specializing in photography and video production. Over the decades, Alex earned 10 US patents and invented the Video Color Negative Analyzer for motion pictures earning him an Academy Award for technical achievement. Many inventions, developed by PCS, are on permanent display at the Smithsonian Institution. Locally Alex also owned television station WPEC TV-12, the CBS affiliate in West Palm Beach. Alex's many philanthropic achievements include founding the Palm Beach County Cultural Council, the Raymond F. Kravis Center for the Performing Arts and gifting a million dollars to the Dreyfoos School of the Arts.
