As a Historical Perspective, its interesting to re-read a warning form a Founding Father regarding the danger of the nations' government using the legal system to impede on the rights of its citizens. His warning could have been written today! *In 1784 Alexander Hamilton wrote the following warning:*

"Nothing is more common than for a free people, in times of heat and violence, to gratify momentary passions, by letting into the government, principles and precedents which afterwards prove fatal to themselves. Of this kind is the doctrine of disqualification, disfranchisement and banishment by acts of legislature.

The dangerous consequences of this power are manifest. If the legislature can disfranchise any number of citizens at pleasure by general descriptions, it may soon confine all the votes to a small number of partisans, and establish an aristocracy or an oligarchy;

if it may banish at discretion all those whom particular circumstances render obnoxious, without hearing or trial, no man can be safe, nor know when he may be the innocent victim of a prevailing faction. The name of liberty applied to such a government would be a mockery of common sense."

"I HAVE NOT YET BEGUN TO FIGHT"

April 23, 1778, *Commander John Paul Jones* led a small detachment of two boats from his ship, the USS *Ranger*, to raid the shallow port at *Whitehaven, England*, where, by his own account, 400 British merchant ships are anchored.

Commander Jones was hoping to reach the port at midnight when ebb tide would leave the ships at their most vulnerable. Jones and his 30 volunteers had greater difficulty than anticipated rowing to the port, which was protected by two forts. They did not arrive until dawn.

His team of *Patriots* in the first boat successfully took over the Southern Fort, disabling its cannons, the other boat however returned without attempting an attack on the Northern Fort after the sailors claimed to have been frightened away by noises.

To compensate, **Commander Jones** set fire to the Southern Fort, which subsequently engulfed the entire town of *Whitehaven* scoring an important patriot victory of the *Revolutionary War*.

Commander Jones, one of the most daring and successful naval commanders of the *American Revolution*, was born in Scotland on July 6, 1747. He was apprenticed to a merchant at the age of 13 and soon went to sea from *Whitehaven*, the very port he returned to attack on this day in 1778.

In *Virginia* at the onset of the Revolution, Jones sided with the Patriots and received a commission as a First Lieutenant in the *Continental Navy* on December 7, 1775.

After the raid on *Whitehaven*, Jones continued to his home territory of *Kirkcudbright Bay*, where he intended to abduct the British alley, the *Earl of Selkirk*, then exchange him for American sailors held captive by *Britain*. Although he did not find the Earl at home, Jones' crew was able to steal all his silver, including his wife's teapot, still containing her breakfast tea.

From Scotland, Jones sailed across the Irish Sea to Carrick Fergus, where the USS Ranger captured the HMS Drake after delivering fatal wounds to the British ship's Captain and First Lieutenant.

In September 1779, Jones fought one of the fiercest battles in naval history when he led the *USS Bonhomme Richard* frigate, named for *Benjamin Franklin*, in an engagement with the mighty 50-gun *British* warship, *HMS Serapis*. The *USS Bonhomme Richard* pounded by the enemy cannons caught fire and started taking on water.

When the *Captain* of the *Serapis* ordered Jones to surrender, Jones famously replied, "Sir, I have not yet begun to Fight!" A few hours later, the captain and crew of the mighty *HMS Serapis* surrendered and Commander Jones took command of the British warship.



Commander Jones went on to establish himself as one of the great naval commanders in history; he is remembered, along with **John Barry**, as a **Father of the American Navy**.

Commander Jones is buried in a crypt in the **U.S. Naval Academy Chapel** at Annapolis where a **US Marine Corp Honor Guard** stands at attention in his honor whenever the crypt is open to the public.
